The mentoring forms can come from combination of: NSEF approved judging clinics, shadow judging, and individual mentoring at competition.

○ Judging Experience – Submit resume of judging experience for the past 5 years (more can be included if desired). Please include dates, competitions, classes, hours, and any additional judging clinics. Minimum of 5 competitions in the last 5 years\*.
